 (1) My place of residence is **718 East 9th St., New York, N.Y.** (2) My occupation is **brazier maker**  
 (3) I was born in **Grajewo, Poland** on **February 26, 1886**. My race is **Polish**  
 (4) I declared my intention to become a citizen of the United States on **April 21, 1936** in the **U.S. District Court of Southern District of New York, N.Y.**  
 (5) I am **married**. The name of my wife is **Elizabeth**  
 we were married on **January 28, 1911** at **New York, N.Y.** She was born at **Lelos, Hungary** on **November 19, 1886**; entered the United States at **New York, N.Y.** on **March 1, 1906** for permanent residence therein, and now resides at **718 East 9th St., New York, N.Y.** I have **3** children, and the name, date, and place of birth, and place of residence of each of said children are as follows: **Julia, February 25, 1912; Helen, January 28, 1918; Christina, September 29, 1925. All born and reside at New York.**

(6) My last foreign residence was **Grajewo, Poland**. I emigrated to the United States of America from **Bremen, Germany**. My lawful entry for permanent residence in the United States was at **Baltimore, Md.**, under the name of **Aleksander Kaliszewski**, on **March 22, 1905** on the vessel **Nittiekind**.

(7) I am not a citizen of or a subject of any organized government or a member of or affiliated with any organization or body of citizens teaching doctrine in or opposed to organized government. I am not a participant nor a member of any organization which is in opposition to the principles of the Constitution of the United States and will disgorge to the good order and happiness of the United States. It is my intention to become a citizen of the United States, and to renounce absolutely and forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly to **The Republic of Poland**.

(8) I am not at this time a subject (or citizen), and it is my intention to reside permanently in the United States. (9) I am able to speak the English language.  
 (9) I have resided continuously in the United States of America for the term of 5 years at least immediately preceding the date of this petition, to wit, since **March 22, 1905** and in the County of **New York**  
 this State, continuously preceding the date of this petition, since **March 22, 1905** being a residence within said county of at least 6 months next preceding the date of this petition. Petition filed under Act of June 22, 1906, as amended.


